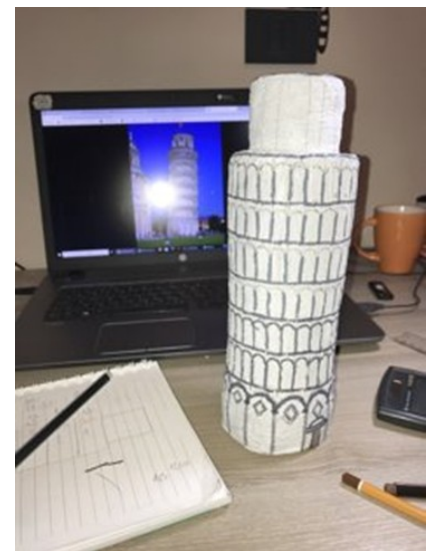
How to make Leaning Tower of Pisa from recycled materials

Country - ITALY

1. 2 recycled plastic bottles of different size
2. Toilet paper
3. Black pencil and tempera colour
4. Special glue (for plastic, wood, etc)

Step by step

1. Cut plastic bottles to make 2 pieces - top and bottom
2. Glue them together with strong special glue (mekol)
3. Cover the bottles with the glue (use the brush) and then cover with the toilet paper all around.
4. After it dries draw the archs with the pencil and colour with





We will learn

How to make Partenon from recycled materials

Country - GREECE

1. Recycled cardboard
2. Paper (or recycled paper towel rolls)
3. Hot glue
4. Stanley knife
5. Ruler

Activity step by step

1. Draw parts of Partenon on a sheet of cardboard, cut out carefully with a stanley knife.
2. Make rolls from paper (or use recycled rolls of paper towels).
3. Glue the parts with hot glue.

How to make Pula Arena (Roman amphitheater) from recycled materials

Country - CROATIA

1. 1 recycled plastic bucket
2. Toilet paper
3. Black pencil and tempera colours
4. Special glue (for plastic, wood, etc)
5. Brush, scissors

Step by step

1. Cover the plastic bucket with the glue (use the brush) and then cover it with the toilet paper all around.
2. After it dries draw the archs with the pencil and colour with tempera colours

1. White and brown cardboard
2. Special glue (mekol) or hot glue

3. Glue the parts together with hot glue or mekol

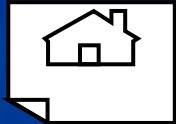
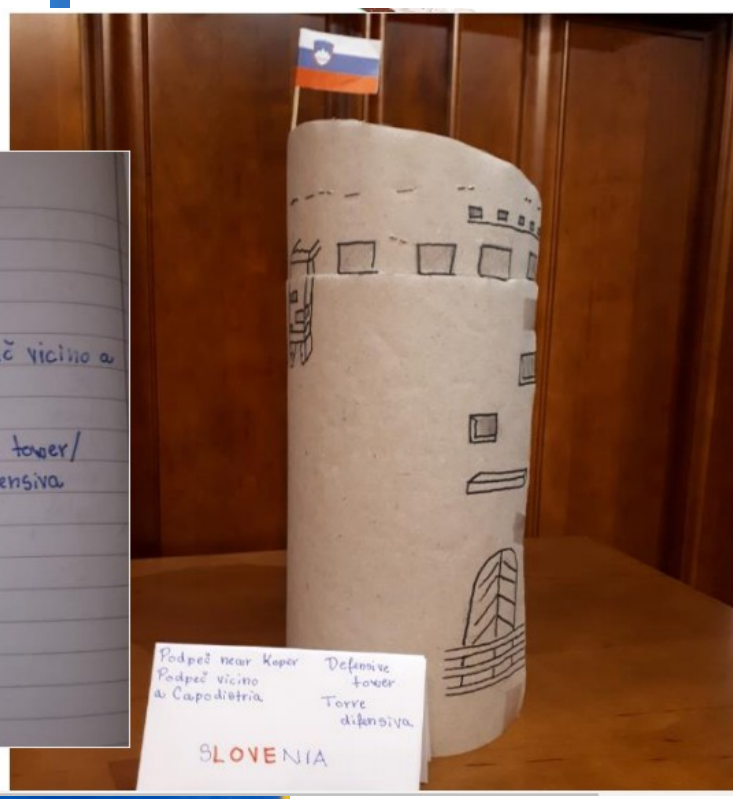

Istrian Kroštole

How to make Istrian Kroštole (flancati)

Country - SLOVENIA

- 200 g. flour
- 3 egg yolks
- salt
- 1 tablespoon sugar
- 1 tablespoon sour cream
- 2 tablespoons rum
- castor sugar
- 1 sachet vanilla sugar

Step by step

Sift the flour. Whisk the egg yolks together with a pinch of salt. Pour in the whisked egg yolks, sour cream rum into the flour and knead into a firm pastry. Cover and set aside for 30 minutes and then roll out thinly. Using a fluted pastry-cutting wheel, cut into strips, cut inside and twist. Fry them in hot oil. Sprinkle the fried, hot kroštule with a mixture of



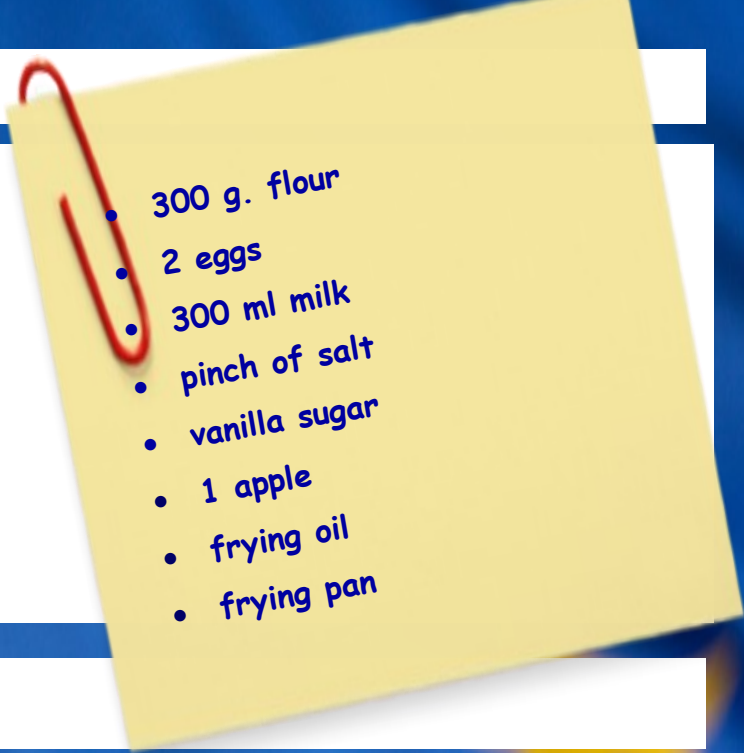
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Lithuanian pancakes

How to make Lithuanian pancakes

Country - LITHUANIA



Step by step

Whisk the eggs together with a pinch of salt and vanilla sugar. Pour in the whisked eggs and milk into the flour and mix well. Mix in the grated apple. Fry small pancakes (one big spoon of the mixture) in hot oil on a frying pan. Serve with jam, whipped cream or sour-cream and sugar.

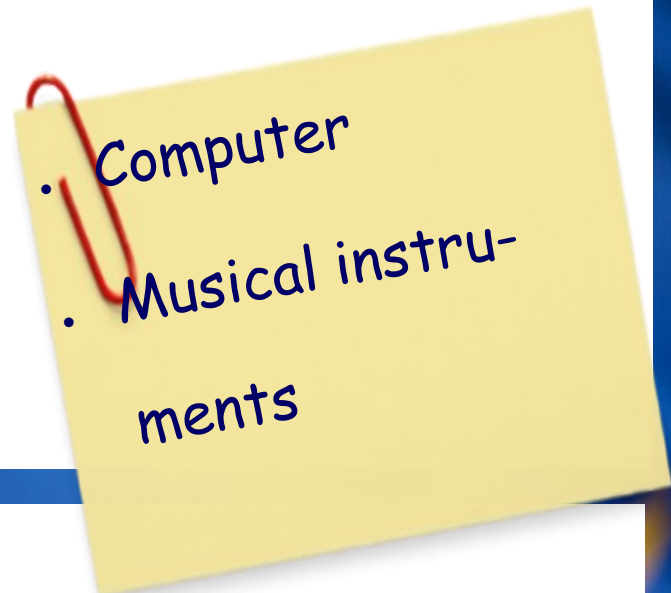




Musically... i love you... Europe!!!

ACTIVITY STEP BY STEP

1. We talked about the great composer L.v. Beethoven. A few biographical details and we mentioned his most important works. One of which is the 9th agreement. The melody of the last part became in 1985 officially the Anthem of Europe. We worked on different rhythmic patterns and all the children experimented with the percussion instruments of our school.
2. Two students playing violin and lyre respectively. These two instruments dominate the traditional music of Crete. The violin dominates in Chania and Agios Nikolaos while the lyre is the main instrument in Rethymno and Heraklion. We talked about the elements of our traditional music, historical elements and influences from the conquerors of the island (Venetian violin and lute).
3. Sang a well-known pop song from the 60's. The words were adapted to "host" our friends from Lithuania and Slovenia. We adapted the phrase "I love you in various European languages" to know the rhythmic percussions of the school in a pleasant way. We saw the

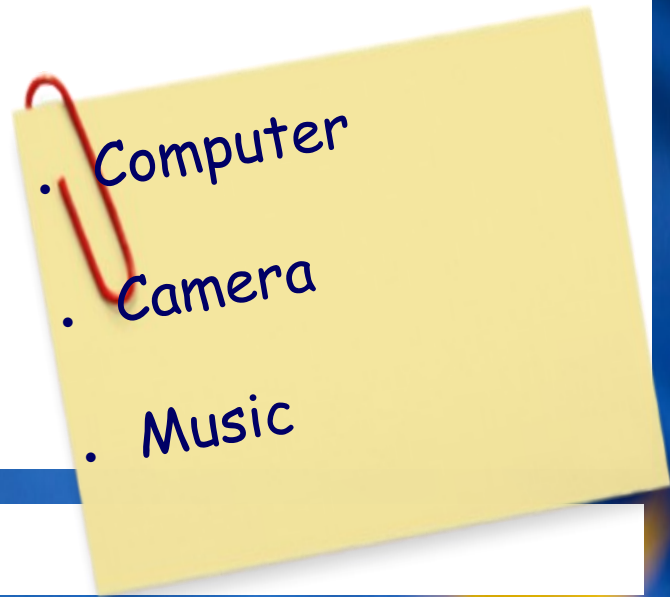
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Dancing with Europe
